Driver Education is offered as an elective course at LCHS. Classes have very limited space. Students who turn in their form to the front office by May 20 will be placed on a list in order of age (oldest to youngest). Our goal is to be able to accept every request, but priority will be given to older students. Safety protocols will be in place to reduce risk of exposure for teacher/ students while driving.

Students who are age 15 by Sept 1 will be eligible for Driver's Ed during the 1st semester. Students who turn 15 after Sept. 1 and before January 31 will be eligible for Driver's Ed during the 2nd semester (after Christmas break). Driver's Ed students must have a PERMIT.

Students assigned to Driver's Ed will receive an email in August from Robyn Hutto that includes payment directions and deadline, Google classroom log in, and class access code. The cost of Driver's Ed is \$30. Checks (payable to LCHS) are due upon assignment to the course, and are receipted by Robyn Hutto. Students who do not pay by the deadline (noted in the email) will be removed from the roster.

Information sheet for parent and parental permission form

THE STUDENT MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERION TO RECEIVE THE DRIVER'S LICENSE CERTIFICATE:

1. Have a valid Alabama learner's license.
2. Have a signed parental permission form on file in order to participate.
3. Successfully fulfill all the skill requirements as set forth by DPS and SDE.
4. Successfully complete Driver Education.

REMINDERS CONCERNING THE CERTIFICATES:

1. There will be no replacement certificates issued.
2. **The certificate is not valid until the student turns sixteen years of age and has held a learner's license for at least six months.**
3. Once the student turns sixteen and has held a learner's license for six months they may take the DPS/SDE certificate, along with their learner's license, to the DPS office (not the probate office) and obtain a driver's license.
4. The certificate cannot be laminated or altered in any manner.
5. Passing Driver Education does not guarantee that the student will receive the DPS/SDE driver's license certificate.
6. The certificate is not a valid document to use in lieu of a driver's license.
