Senior Business

1. **CAP AND GOWN** must be ordered by **Feb 10** (extended date); shipping and handling goes up when your order is late. Order online at mrmgradsales.com. Click Senior products, our school logo, then scroll to the bottom to the picture of the cap and gown.
 - a. Those who have not ordered by Feb 10 WILL NOT have a diploma ordered, as this is part of that fee. This is a separate fee from your senior fees to LCHS for prom!!!! Senior fee for prom is due to Mrs. Rogers or Mrs. Woods.
2. Last call for name / spelling corrections for diploma order. Look in INOW or on your transcript – this is how it will appear on your diploma. You **MUST** notify Mrs. Martin by Feb 10 to take care of any changes.

5. EVERYONE should be finished with applications for admission, and should be finishing scholarship applications for your colleges. DIG into your school’s scholarship website for departmental, leadership, and foundation scholarships!
6. Complete your 2021-2022 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) for school year beginning Fall 2021. Using your 2019 tax return info, fill out the FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov. EVERYONE GOING TO COLLEGE SHOULD COMPLETE THE FAFSA. **Then follow up with your college financial aid office.** If you need help, make an appointment with Mrs. Bentley: 256-566-0782.
7. Reminder about Summer 2021 pell grant (2020-2021 FAFSA using 2018 tax returns)... if you plan to start college in the summer.
8. Notify your college’s Financial Aid office if your ACT has gone up since you applied. Make sure they have the new score to apply to \$\$.
9. Check on your college’s summer orientation dates and registration requirements. Time to register for HOUSING NOW!!!
10. If you have not taken the US Civics Exam (required for graduation) – prepare at civisquiz.com and plan to test in March w/ Mr. Bradford.
11. Placement Testing at Calhoun / NWS for those who do not have ACT scores to place them in 100-level courses.
 - a. English 18 = EN 101 Math 18 = MTH 100
 - b. Calhoun testing lab is open Monday – Thursday 9am-2:30 pm, Building 9, \$10 retest fee. Call 306-2522.
